ORDINANCE NO. 299

Series of 1904.
An Ordinance levying a tax upon the taxable property within the City of La Grande, Oregon, for general and special municipal purposes.

The City of La Grande Does Ordain As Follows:—

Section one:—That there be and hereby is levied upon the taxable property within the City of La Grande Union County, Oregon, a tax of 5 mills on the dollar for general municipal purposes of the City of La Grande, Oregon.

Section two:—That there be and hereby is levied upon the taxable property within the City of La Grande Union County, Oregon, a tax of 8 mills on the dollar for the purpose of paying the interest on the outstanding bonds of the City of La Grande, said interest becoming due on the 1st day of July 1905 and the first day of January 1906, and for the further purpose of repaying money heretofore borrowed for the purpose of paying interest on said bonds.

Section three:—That the levies of said taxes set out in Sections one and two of this ordinance shall be made and collected upon the property within the City of La Grande, Oregon, as shown by the assessment thereof as made and returned by the County assessor to the County Clerk of Union County for the year 1904.

Section four:—That the money arising from the tax levied by virtue of Section one of this ordinance, as fast as collected, shall be turned over to the Treasurer of the City of La Grande and shall by him be placed in the general fund of said City.

That the money arising from the tax levied by virtue of section two of this Ordinance as fast as collected, shall be turned over to the Treasurer of the City of La Grande, Oregon, and shall be by him placed in and kept as a special fund for the payment of interest on the outstanding bonds of the City of La Grande, Oregon, as herein provided and for the purpose of repaying money heretofore borrowed by said City for the purpose of paying interest on said bonds.

Section Five:—That all of said taxes shall be collected in cash and no part thereof shall be payable in City warrants.

Section Six:—That the Recorder shall certify this ordinance to the County Clerk of Union County, Oregon, on or before the first day of January 1905, to be carried upon the assessment roll and the tax to be collected in the manner provided by law.

Section seven:—That this Ordinance shall be published in the La Grande Evening Observer for one issue there-

of and shall be in full force and take effect from and after the 27th day of December 1904.

Passed by the Council of the City of La Grande, Oregon, on the 21st day of December 1904, by six members voting therefor.
