COUNTY COURT AND COMMISSION REACH AGREEMENT

The controversy between the state highway commission and the Polk county court has been settled again according to the press news.

They agreed to designate the road from the Luckiamute bridge to Monmouth as a market road and the Polk county court is to turn over to the highway commission \$43,000 from the market road fund for that project. If it takes more to finance the roadbed construction over that part, the highway commission is to furnish the amount in excess of the \$43,000; but if requires less than the \$43,000 the county is to be credited with the difference between the actual expense and the \$43,000.

It was further agreed that the highway commission is to loan the county sufficient money to complete the construction of the road south from the Luckiamute bridge to the Benton county line and is also to supply, by loan, what money is required to build the road north to Rickreall to connect with that portion of the highway which is already constructed at the north side of the county. In return for this assistance, the county will pay the highway commission \$10,000 per year out of the motor vehicle license fund and \$15,000 per year out of the general road fund, making a total of \$25,000 per year which will be paid to the highway commission until the indebtedness incurred for this road construction is fully paid.
