Chemawa has a brick school building which was erected at a cost of \$15,000 and is steam heated and electric lighted and ventilated throughout. It has slate black boards, wide commodious halls and 10 class rooms in addition to the office, bookroom and large assembly hall, which has a capacity of 750. There are 10 teachers allowed and the studies taught include those of the grammar school grade.
