Family fishing event slated at St. Louis Ponds April 15

The Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife will host a free family fishing event April 15 at St. Louis Ponds near Woodburn from 9:30 a.m. to 2 p.m.

The ponds will be stocked with legal and larger-sized rainbow trout shortly before the event. ODFW will provide equipment including rods, reels, and bait for use during the event on a first-come-firstserve basis.

Angling education instructors and volunteers will be present to answer questions and offer assistance to less experienced anglers.

St. Louis Ponds is a 54acre complex of seven ponds jointly owned and managed by ODFW and Marion County Parks. In addition to stocked trout, the ponds contain several species of warm water fish, including largemouth bass, catfish, bluegill, crappie, and sunfish.




12 to 17 will require a youth license, which are available for \$10 at ODFW's website www. odfw.com. Adult anglers will need a regular fishing license.


Licenses will not be sold on site the day of the event so people planning to participate should get their license ahead of time.




