

Symphony presents 'Expressions of Love'

North Oregon Coast Symphony presents "Expressions of Love," in two concerts. The first is at 7 p.m. Friday May 29 at Clatsop Community College's Performing Arts Center, 588 16th St. in Astoria. It is repeated at 3 p.m. Sunday, May 31 at the Rockaway Beach

Community Church, 400 S. Third Ave., Rockaway Beach. Admission is \$12 at the door; children younger than 12 are free.

Musical selections explore and express the range of emotions that love provides in a relationship. The concerts will

begin with performances by the chamber groups, featuring woodwind, brass and string ensembles, and solo piano. The full orchestra, conducted by Cory Pederson, will then perform three pieces: "Romeo & Juliet Overture" by Tchaikovsky, Verdi's "I Masn-

adieri Preludio" cello concerto, and "Asturias" by Isaac Albeniz (originally composed for solo piano, but very popular in the classical guitar repertoire).

The North Oregon Coast Symphony is a group of musicians who come from a 100-mile span of the North Oregon and South Washington coasts to rehearse and create classical music programs for the local community's enjoyment. This all-volunteer symphony is committed to growing into a sustainable arts organization, offering concerts, chamber

groups, music education and scholarships. There are ongoing opportunities for community members to become involved as performing musicians or support staff. Players from high school to adult, proficient to professional are welcome.
