

SLOW MARCH OF GLACIERS.

Test Which Proved that Rivers of Ice Move but Few Feet Each Year. It had long been supposed that no true glaciers remain in the Rockies south of Wyoming, a supposition now known to be incorrect. North of Long's peak two icefields have been described and referred to as glaciers by men whose determinations are entitled to considerable weight, though on the whole they partake more of the nature of nerve and are so considered by some geologists.

This difference of opinion is entirely excusable on the ground that the dividing line between nerve and glacier is indistinct, the one passing into the oth er by insensible gradation. However, explorations carried on in the last five years have brought to light an ice PRICES RIGHT stream which is so distinctly a glacier as to leave no chance for a dispute as to its character.
