**NEW ERA IN PHARAOH'S LAND.**  
 Ancient Country Reported Making  
 Great Industrial Progress.  
 Current indications are of the drawing  
 of a new era in Egypt, or at least  
 of a considerable further development  
 of the new era which was provided for  
 just thirty years ago, and which one  
 of the greatest statesmen of the age  
 has done so much to promote during  
 his unrivaled administration of the  
 last twenty-three years, says the New  
 York Tribune. From year to year Lord  
 Cromer's reports have shown Egypt to  
 be making social, political and industrial  
 progress such as few renaissance  
 lands have ever achieved or approximated  
 to. Now two further steps are  
 being taken. One is the strong self-  
 assertion of Egypt against the aggres-  
 sions of Turkey. The other is the re-  
 organization of legislative and judicial  
 affairs, proposed by Lord Cromer, of  
 which brief mention has been made in  
 dispatches.

Lord Cromer's proposal have to do  
 chiefly with the capitulations, the consular  
 courts and the mixed tribunals, to  
 which are committed the interests  
 of foreigners resident in Egypt. The  
 present system, he argues, is out of date  
 and incompatible with existing condi-  
 tions. His suggestion is that there  
 shall be substituted a new legislative  
 council, composed of twenty-five or thirty  
 members, all of whom shall be citi-  
 zens or subjects, or protected sub-  
 jects, of the signatories of the treaties  
 of 1876, care being taken that no one  
 power shall have an undue number.  
 Legislation enacted by a majority of  
 this council and promulgated by the  
 Egyptian government, with the approval  
 of the British government, is to be  
 binding upon all foreign residents of  
 Egypt.

The council is to create new courts  
 to take the place of the consular courts  
 and the mixed tribunals, in which new  
 courts and present judges of the mixed  
 tribunals will be entitled to places. Two  
 principles of irremovability of judges  
 is to be maintained and no change is  
 to be made in the fundamental prin-  
 ciples of civil and criminal jurispru-  
 dence. The Suez canal convention, the  
 law of the public debt and some other  
 matters are to be excluded from the  
 jurisdiction of this new council and  
 there is to be no change in the compo-  
 sition or functions of the existing leg-  
 islative council and assembly.

The changes thus proposed by Lord  
 Cromer are important, and will require  
 careful consideration before they are  
 finally passed upon by the powers con-  
 cerned. The authorship of them com-  
 mends them, however, to favorable at-  
 tention, as does also that feature of  
 the general scheme which deals with  
 the subject of international impartiality  
 in Egypt. Lord Cromer lays special  
 stress upon the maintenance of the  
 open door and of entire equality of com-  
 mercial and all other privileges for  
 all the powers, prescribing, at the out-  
 set, an engagement by the British and  
 Egyptian governments that every reser-  
 vation in favor of British subjects shall  
 inure to the benefit of the subjects of  
 other powers. Assurance of such equal-  
 ity of treatment being made, there  
 would seem to be little else for the  
 powers to ask in giving their assent to  
 the new system.

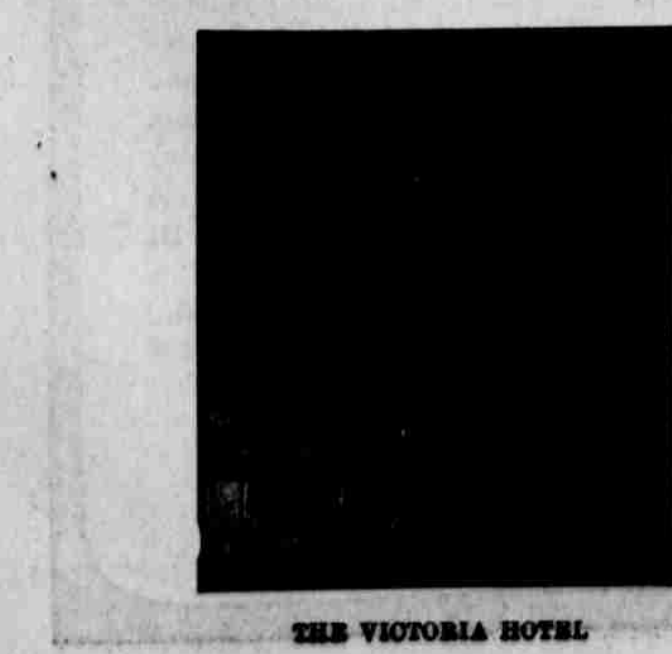
