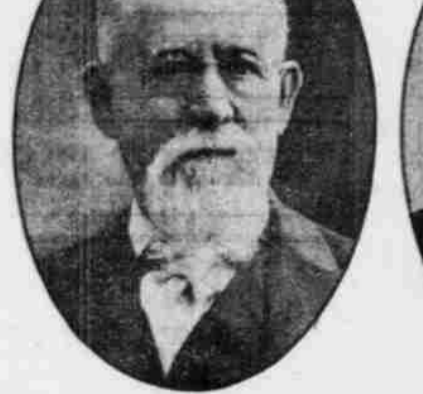
LAW FOR JURY DRAWING
