



## PROTECTION



The renter of a safe-deposit box in this vault has not only the greatest protection against the skilled burglar and fire, but also has protection against mob violence.


The safety-deposit system, as a whole, is one of the most interesting sights in the United States.

Every citizen of the City of Portland and vicinity should see this most interesting sight and be in a position to show and explain to their visiting friends, from other cities, this most wonderful system of security.




VIEW OF SAFE-DEPOSIT VAULT SHOWING DOOR CLOSED

VIEW OF COIN VAULT SHOWING INTERIOR


