In the 2nd century, certain African explorers, whose stories are more picturesque than convincing, report that they found in Osetia asparagus of excellent quality and very beautiful growth, no less than 13 feet high. With these figures before me, I hesitate in describing some choice asparagus seen in the Portland markets as "large and fine." But there were some bundles of "fancy quality" at 20 cents a bunch, which were very attractive and would suit my sense of appetite much better than the Ravenna or Osetia kind. Good, plain asparagus, without "filling," would be had for 12 1/2 cents a pound.
