

PROVISIONAL COUNCIL CREATED IN BERLIN

Move for Organization of New Government On.

ASSEMBLY NOW DEMANDED

Russian Bolshevik Authorities Notified Representatives Are Not Wanted in Germany.

AMSTERDAM, Nov. 18.—A provisional council has been formed at Berlin under the presidency of Dr. Reiser, head of the Hansa League, for the organization of a citizens' committee to safeguard the rights of citizens and to support the government.

BASEL, Nov. 18.—(Havas.)—The German authorities, according to a dispatch from Berlin, have notified the Russian Bolshevik government that representatives must not be sent to Germany.

BASEL, Switzerland, Nov. 18.—Prince Maximilian of Baden, former German Imperial Chancellor, in an article in the Prussian Year Book, in which he reveals certain facts about his brief term in the chancellery, says: "The German people by the formation of a popular government are liberated from the dictatorship of General Ludendorff and will never tolerate another."

"It would be a shame for Germany if its enemies wished to talk into a constituent assembly. The government should not surrender this initiative. If it governs democratically, it can be assured of the support of all Germans animated by liberal ideas in the accomplishment of its task."

"An attempt was in the making to oust completely the coalition government. In the first clash in connection with this move, General Ludendorff gave in to the government, but in the second clash he resigned."
