Films of Pedro Infante Showcasing Golden Age of Mexican cinema

This March and April, the Hollywood Theatre's Cinescopio series returns for its second year, this time showcasing the films of Pedro Infante, one of Mexico's most enduring film icons.

One of the greatest actors of the Golden Age of Mexican cinema, Pedro Infante is considered an idol of the Latin American people—sitting alongside fellow actors/crooners Jorge Negrete and Javier Solis as the "Three Mexican Roosters".

Though his reign on the silver screen was short-lived (from 1939 until his untimely death in 1957), Infante starred in more than 60 films. Blending romance, adventure, and song, his films bring critical light to social issues that are still relevant in Mexico and Latin America today—racism, classism, and socioeconomic disparity.

Cinescopio, a series celebrating classic Latin American cinema, will honor Pedro Infante through three

film screenings, taking place March 5, March 28, and April 15 and accompanied by post-film panel discussions, family activities, and a musical presentation. The films are presented in Spanish with English subtitles and will show as follows:
