

PLAYED WITH LOADED GUN

OAKLAND WOMAN SHOTS HERSELF IN THE THIGH.

While Enacting the Role of a Highwayman in Jest, the Revolver Is Discharged.

OAKLAND, Cal., Dec. 9. (Special.)—While toying with a small revolver and playfully enacting the part of a hold-up man, Mrs. Nellie Gale, proprietress of the International House, 230 Eighth street, accidentally shot herself through the thigh and sustained a painful although not necessarily a serious wound. She was at once removed to Providence Hospital, where the leaden missile was soon extracted and just now hopes are held out that her recovery is certain, although there is always danger from blood-poisoning in such cases.

MALHEUR PRECINCTS ARE DRY

Circuit Court Order Overrules Action of County Commissioners.

YALE, Or., Dec. 9. (Special.)—The Circuit Judge of this district has handed down his decision in the local-option case in which the State of Oregon and others were plaintiffs and the County Court of Malheur County was the defendant. The case is a result of the local-option vote November 8, 1904, and the precinct under consideration in this decision was Nyssa, although the decision affects most of the towns in the county.
