NOTES AND NEWS. The capacity of Eugene's water reservoir is being increased to 100,000 gallons. The Salem Light and Power Co. has just received a new 5000-horse power dynamo.

E. W. Warner, a compositor on the Oregon City Enterprise, celebrated his 76th birthday, 63 years of which he has been setting type. The Nehalem river is on a regular bender, ejecting from its mouth all sorts of debris, breaking booms and carrying many logs to the sea.

The Southern Pacific has commenced fencing in its road. It has 800 miles to fence in Marion county alone. It costs \$250 a mile to do this fencing. Stephen Bester was drowned in Wilson river, Tillamook county recently, while ferrying hay across the stream. His son barely escaped the same fate.

The assessors at Portland passed the following resolution: That the records will not be resorted to for the purpose of listing mortgage notes for assessment, excepting when tax payers refuse to give in their property. H. E. Cross, was fined \$100 and cost or 50 days' confinement in our cosy cooler by Squire Fouts on Friday, for throwing sawdust in the Clackamas river.

Oregon's new soldiers' home is to be located at Roseburg. Some of the Salem papers are making a kick on this location, claiming that it should according to law, be placed in that city. Roseburg is situated in a better climate than the capital city, and the old vets are fortunate in that respect.

At the annual encampment of the Grand Army of the Republic, and Woman's Relief Corps, held at Pendleton last week, several hundred members were present, and the following officers were elected for the ensuing year: Commander, J. C. Cooper, Custer Post No. 9, McMinnville; Sr. Vice Commander, W. W. Braum, Kit Carson Post No. 28, Pendleton; Jr. Vice Commander, R. S. Greenleaf, George Wright Post No. 1, Portland; Medical Director, O. M. Dodson, Joe Post No. 20, Baker City; Chaplain, Rev. G. W. Gae, Lincoln-Garfield Post No. 3, Portland; Assistant Adj. General, D. H. Turner, Geo. Wright Post, Portland.

FEMALE CONVICTS. Mrs. Phoebe Richardson, aged 50, with her husband confined in the penitentiary a few days ago for one year each for hacking to pieces a buggy and harness belonging to Mrs. Kate Parsell, of Heppner, in a spirit of revenge. She took her imprisonment coolly, better satisfied that her husband is with her. She is the twelfth woman on the list of female prisoners.

Mary Mack, from Multnomah county, for larceny, July 12, 1870, pardoned on her arrival. Maggie Marshall, a half caste Kanaka, from Multnomah, one year for larceny, July 6, 1872; pardoned June 13, 1873. Caroline Briggs, Jackson county, for five years for manslaughter, December 4, 1875; pardoned January 31, 1877.

Carrie Bradley, from Multnomah county, 12 years for manslaughter, June 21, 1882; pardoned June 21, 1893. She was the keeper of a house of ill fame on Third street in Portland, and two of her girls, Dolly Adams and Mollie Flippin, enticed an old rancher from Sauvie's island to their room in Carrie Bradley's house, and intending to put him to sleep to get his money, Dolly gave him too much chloroform. When he was found to be dead to keep the matter quiet Carrie Bradley hired a hack and a couple of men to take the body at night and throw it in the river below Weidler's mill.

Lizzie Falls and Florence Fallon, from Multnomah county, were the next, sentenced one year for robbery, May 13, 1887; pardoned April 13, 1888. Edith Holmes, from Clatsop, one year for larceny, October 5, 1889; pardoned September 7, 1890. Hazel Nelson, from Multnomah, one year for robbery, January 30, 1890. She was about to be a mother. Mrs. Dr. Tomale, Vivian Van was the thirteenth. Her case attracted as much attention as Carrie Bradley's, and an officer of the penitentiary says that there is much curiosity to see her should she go to that institution.
