The Saturday night previous to the day of holding the convention, Mr. Lincoln and the other nominee, took that banner and nailed it to the flagstaff rising from the centre of the dome on the court house. The rext morning a favoring breeze stretched the banner out, and I heard Mr. Bal!, one of the delegates to the convention, next day say, in reply to a ques- Driven Well & Force Pumps, tion, "See it I d-n the thing, I could read it as soon as I got out of the Lick creek timber!" The convention met. It was a solenm affiairmade their nominations-after which the Journal came out with a ticket on which were the names of Lincoln, Dawson, Wilson, Edwards, Fletcher, and four others, (I have forgotten their names), measuring altogether 53 Of all kinds done promptly and in a satisfacto feet 9 inches. This ticket was elected and called the "Long Nine." This was the first time the opposition ever succeeded in Sangamon county; and they held it up to the time of the Francis' selling out the Journal.
