**WILL GO TO COURT.**—The Oregon and Transcontinental Company some time ago made a claim against the Northern Pacific Railroad Company for a considerable balance claimed to be due on business. The Northern Pacific Company after investigating the claim now asserts that the debt is on the other foot, and that the Oregon and Transcontinental Company is debtor to it to the amount of at least \$1,000,000. It is said that the Northern Pacific intends to establish this claim in the courts.—Railway Age.

**An order of the United States Circuit Court,** in the case of William Sharon vs. Sarah Althea Hill, to declare invalid the alleged marriage contract held by the defendant, has been made. It decrees that the document purporting to be a declaration of marriage be delivered by the defendant to the clerk of the court, to be cancelled by writing the words "Cancelled by this decree," across it, and that said document remain in the custody of the clerk, subject to a further order of the court.

As another proof of the strong growth of the temperance sentiment among the people and in legislative circles, can be mentioned the fact that on Thursday the Territorial Legislature of Washington, passed the local-option bill, after a thorough discussion, without a dissenting vote, and amid the loudest applause.

The southern states have put in their work upon the measure and in a most satisfactory manner, and now the territories are awaiting the infection and helping to spread the universal application of the reform.

The states that have already been at work upon the subject will receive new courage and bring in a power that will push legislation through to a successful termination. The growth of temperance sentiment and work has been very slow, but it has nevertheless been constant and increasing year after year, and the final outcome will be a full and complete victory for the movement.

Temperance men and women may be fanatic but it is the sort of fanaticism that will win in the end.

**AGRICULTURAL STATISTICS.**—According to the information of the National Department of Agriculture the area of corn in the United States in 1885 was 73,000,000 acres, of wheat 34,000,000, of oats 23,000,000. The value of corn averages nearly 33 cents per bushel and makes an aggregate of \$635,000,000, \$5,000,000 less than the value of the last crop. The decrease in the product of wheat is 30 per cent and only 17 per cent in value; which is \$275,000,000. The reduction in wheat is mostly in the valley of the Ohio and in California.

The States of Ohio, Indiana, Illinois, Missouri and Kansas, last year, produced 170,000,000 bushels, this year 80,000,000. The production of all cereals is 53 bushels to each inhabitant and the aggregate volume is greater than any former year.
