THE BUTTER CREEK SITUATION. The Butter creek scare has not yet terminated. Families from the mouth of the creek to its very head, are daily leaving for places of safety, some having gone to Portland, some to Puget Sound, Walla Walla and many are in Pendleton.

FROM THE WALLOWA VALLEY.

WALLOWA, July 17, 1877. EDITOR EAST OREGONIAN.—Permit me through the columns of your live paper to publish a few items which may be of considerable advantage to the government in the present conflict with Joseph's band of Indians.

About the first day of the present month I in company with a man by the name of J. C. Ward, who has had a great deal of experience as a mountaineer and Indian fighter, having been through the Rogue river war, started from Grand Ronde valley to scout the country lying between Walla Walla and Snake rivers, to ascertain if possible whether any Indians were southwest of Snake river in the vicinity of the Wallowa valley.
