The result is of interest to this upper country, especially while freight is so high; and that is caused fruits which I have been engaged in. I have canned 450 one-half gallon cans of blackberries, equal to 500 quarts or 75 dozen; 94 one-half gallon cans peaches or 8 dozen; 53 dozen quart cans peaches; 13 dozen quart cans tomatoes; 134 one-half gallon cans pears or 15 dozen. Total, 164 quarts.
