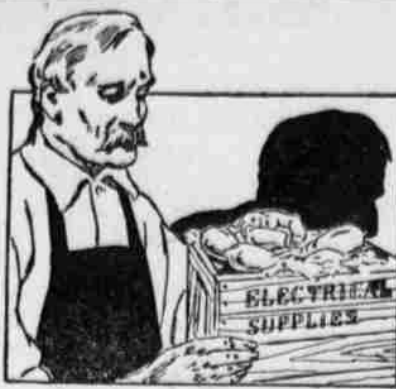

MILWAUKEE TO BUY STEAMERS

Rumor That New Coast Railway Will Secure Pacific Coast Line.

SAN FRANCISCO, Jan. 16.—It is reported that the Chicago, Milwaukee and St. Paul Railroad Company has absorbed the Pacific Coast Steamship Company and will hereafter operate the steamers of the Pacific Coast Company's fleet.

Harriman is believed to be behind the deal. Although Geo. H. Higbee, general manager of the Pacific company at San Francisco, declares he places little confidence in the report, coast traffic circles are inclined to put some faith in the current rumors.

It is predicted that if the St. Paul company has taken over the Pacific Coast Steamship Company there will be a general rejuvenation of the coast company which will result in a pace of progress which has not been set for three years, or shortly after the earthquake.

Confidence is expressed that with the formal taking over of the Pacific Coast Steamship Company by the St. Paul line attention will be given the needs of the San Francisco-Eureka run along with the requirements of the other Pacific coast routes.

A dispatch from Tacoma, dated Saturday, speaks of the Pacific Coast steamers Umatilla, Queen, City of Puebla, President, and Governor, which are running between Puget Sound and San Francisco. It also states that the itinerary of these ships will be extended south to San Pedro by the railroad company, and that the Puget Sound terminus will be Tacoma, where dredging operations for enormous freight terminals are now in progress.

The Chicago, Milwaukee and St. Paul company now has three branches running west from Chicago toward the Pacific, and is confidently looking forward to the extension of the most northern of these lines, which now stops at Butte, Montana, to Seattle and Tacoma. A middle line runs due west from Watertown, near Milwaukee to Rapid City in South Dakota, and a third line runs west from Chicago to Council Bluffs near Omaha. It is thought that the railroad company will extend the middle line from Rapid City across Wyoming to Ogden, connecting there with the San Pedro, Los Angeles, Salt Lake line.

It will be noted in a glance at the map that if these plans are carried out, on their consummation the Chicago, Milwaukee and St. Paul line will have a system, shaped as a triangle with the apex at Chicago and the base angles at San Pedro and Puget Sound, completed on the coast through the steamers of the Pacific Coast Steamship Company.
