**SEND MAN TO PROBE WRECK**

Investigator Coming to Look Into Coos Bay Life Saving Service.

Word has been received here that the Captain of the United States Revenue Cutter Rush, now doing service in North Pacific waters, has been ordered to Coos Bay to make a detailed investigation of the action of the Coos Bay Life Saving crew at the time of the Czarina disaster. He is expected to reach here on the Ramona next Friday morning.

According to unofficial information received here, all of the evidence secured by Captain Emory, inspector of the life saving service in this district, has been turned over to the new investigator and he is to look into it further and gather such additional evidence as is procurable. It is expected that the Port of Coos Bay which asked for a thorough investigation will cooperate the investigation and have their attorney, C. R. Peck, present at the hearing and also introduce additional testimony of people who witnessed the disaster and the actions of the life saving crew.

According to the rules and regulations of the life saving service, copies of which have recently been secured here, the keeper of a station is required to actually attempt to launch the life saving boat and is not permitted to let his judgment determine whether or not it can be done. There are other regulations, which according to stories told by parties on the beach at the time, were not complied with.
