Marion Reynolds, who is attending college at Berkeley, writes that the weather is beautiful and fruit trees all in blossom.

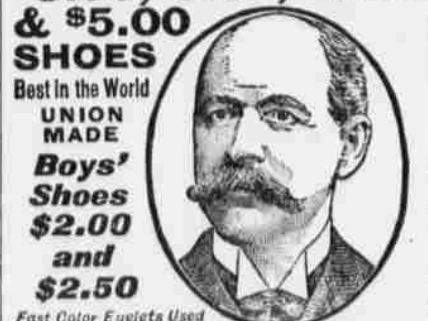
The Mothers' and Teachers' Club will meet Friday afternoon at 3 o'clock, at the Kinney school house.
