To the foreigner, the semi-civilization of China is a mass of contradictions. With their expressly formal etiquette, the Chinese can be brutally rude; with their classic exhortations to honesty, the bribe is a potent force with the coolie and the mandarin alike.

Female children are not desired in any Oriental country, and, as in India, Chinese wives offer sacrifices to the Goddess of Mercy that some may be conserved from the destruction of female children.

There are no exceptions to the general disfavour with which girls are regarded, and this is where male children only have previously been born.

When a child is born the friends and relatives are notified and gifts are presented. The sex of the child determines the value of the present, which are of much less value should the child be a daughter.

Girls are taught to sew and embroider, and, among the poor, to cook to wait the waiting in the spring and wash the clothing for summer.

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Caught His Man on the Fly.

A Veteran Detective's Account of the Worst Half Minute He Ever Had.

"The worst half minute and the happiest recovery I ever had in my experience," said an old detective, "happened in this way:

"I had been hunting for a week for a thief who had made up his mind to trouble me and go away with a lot of people's property, and I got him located one afternoon in a business building that had stores on the first floor and offices above, in which he had been making, in a small way, some pretty good hauls.

I got him in a hall, where there was no escape, except by a window at the front end opening on the street, and I thought all I had to do was to walk up and nail him. And I'd got within fifteen feet of him, smiling to myself when, looking back at me, just one more, away he went! He jumped clean out of the window.

"Automatically and instantaneously I reared down with both hands, one on either side of the man's head, and seized him by the shoulders and hung on, and then I lifted him a little and dragged him in over the window sill back into the hall, and put the bracelets on him. I'd got him after all, and unharmed.

"And of course it was perfectly simple. There was a spring wagon backed up over the sidewalk to the front door of the store on the ground floor, and my man, taking any chance for freedom, and with all but one chance in a thousand of jumping to his death, had landed on that spring wagon with force enough to bound him back up into my hands."—New York Sun.
