NEW HOISTING PLANT FOR BAISLEY-ELKHORN

Baker City, Or., Oct, 5.—Manager Edward T, Fields of the United Elkhorn Mines company, has just placed an order for a 56-horse power hoisting plant, which is to be installed on the old working shaft of the Baialey-Elkhorn.
