Centralia is experiencing a boom. Charles Towley, an actor, committed suicide in Helena Saturday.

C. J. Elder has been arrested in Walla Walla for the murder of John Sommerville, in Seattle, year or more ago.

Charges have been made against Governor Swineford of Alaska, for issuing permits to sell liquor on the island.

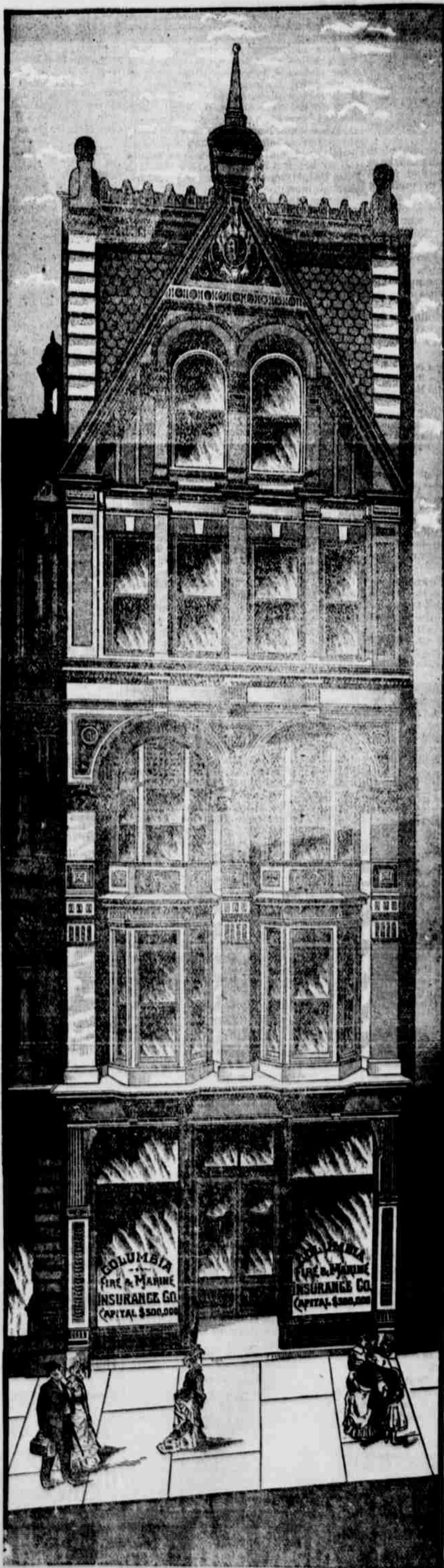
