Union, Umatilla county, John W. Minnick—Splendid growing weather, haying will begin in a few days, crop generally light; fall sown grain has short straw; spring grain is recovering fast from effects of drought.

Lakeview, Lake county, W. E. Wheeler—Week ended cool, with dry northerly winds; grass and grain will make good crops; haying commenced in some localities; berries are plentiful, but fruit in general will be below the average.

SUB-IRRIGATED ALFALFA.

Attained Height of Six and One-Half Feet on the Acels Farm Every Inch Edible.

Milton, July 15.—Alfalfa six and one-half feet high is the phenomenal growth attained from seed planted this spring on the Acels farm, near this city. The farm is now owned by the Walla Walla Meat Company.

The wonderful growth of this patch of alfalfa is due to sub-irrigation; that is, the roots of the plant were at all times immersed in water from an irrigation ditch which percolated through the soil. The sample brought in was in full bloom, the little blue flowers showing along the branches for three or four feet—over a greater area than the height of the ordinary growth.

Livestock feeding on the tall forage plant like it so well that every particle of it is eaten. Its quality is very fine.
