In the State of Georgia, the "Industrial Bureau" have fixed the price of negro labor at \$10 per month for men, and \$8 for women, including board, and ten hours to constitute a day's work. This is much better wages than the laboring classes of England obtain.

A firm in San Francisco who had a ship and cargo destroyed by the *Shenandoah*, have forwarded a bill of \$260,000 to Washington to be filed with other claims for indemnity against England, for property destroyed by English pirates. Similar bills will be presented by the owners of all the other vessels destroyed by the pirates.

THE six New England States, with a population of 3,135,303, and a total Congressional representation of 39 members, furnished 367,946 men to the late war. Pennsylvania, with a population of 2,996,370, and a Congressional representation of only 26, furnished 363,444 soldiers to the war. For each representative in Congress, New England furnished a little over 9,000 soldiers, while Pennsylvania furnished over 13,000 for each one.

A GENTLEMAN who has had a peep at Deady's Criminal Code says prisons, racks and gallows are running all through it—that it embodies the harsh features of all the criminal codes he has ever heard of. He does not know whether or not it contains a sedition law, prohibiting evil speaking of dignitaries—U. S. Judges, and others—but thinks it does. Deady divides mankind into two classes; one of which is to govern, and the other to be governed. The mass of mankind he looks upon as being created merely to be governed.—*Arena*.

EUROPEAN PRECEPT AND EXAMPLE.—The London *Daily News*, while hoping that Jeff. Davis may escape punishment, admits that European example is against any such lenity. It says: If Mr. Davis is to be saved, it must be by the exercise of a magnanimity of which no State of European Christendom affords an example; and the Americans are a people of too much original ability not to be able to ascertain for themselves the course which becomes their character in their present situation.
