

SUBSCRIPTION AND ADVERTISING RATES OF PAPERS MUST RISE

New York, Nov. 13.—The American Newspaper Publishers association went on record today in favor of limitation of the size of newspapers and material increases in advertising and subscription rates.

Franklin P. Glass, president of the association, said cost of producing newspapers had increased 100 per cent in the last year.

New York, Nov. 12.—Newspaper advertising rates must be advanced and advertising space restricted to enable publishers to meet the conditions caused by the existing shortage of print paper.

Glass pointed to the necessity of increasing print paper production while publishers are endeavoring to decrease consumption.

"All the newspapers in the United States are affected by this situation," Glass said. "Some newspapers, even some very big ones, have no supply of news print contracted for next year."

"A Canadian paper manufacturer, I have learned, has just refused an offer for 30,000 tons of news print at 6 cents for six months, there to be an adjustment then for the latter part of the contract."

Reports from every section of the country have shown large gains in attendance figures.
