Here are the first photographs of the Near East Conference being held at Lausanne, Switzerland, to attempt to end the Turkish war. M. Haub, President of Switzerland, presided over the initial conference. Lord Curzon represented England, Premier Mussolini represented Italy and Premier Poincare looked after French interests. M. Venizelos, former Premier of Greece, attended, as did General Weygand, Marshal Foch's right-hand man, and Admiral Lacaze, of the French navy. Ismet Pasha led the Turkish delegation.
