

## FAHS offers hamburgers, pet adoption Saturday

Florence Area Humane Society (FAHS) and Grocery Outlet owner Woody Woodbury invites the public to enjoy hot dogs and hamburgers hot off the grill on Saturday, Feb. 21, from 11 a.m. to 2 p.m., at the Grocery Outlet parking lot.

Woodbury donated the food for the event.

Hamburgers will cost \$3, hot dogs and Polish dogs will be \$2 and cheeseburgers will cost \$3.50. Soda and bottled water are \$1. In addition, homemade cookies and scones created by FAHS volunteers are also available for 50 cents.

Money raised will go to provide care for the once-homeless cats and dogs awaiting their forever home at the FAHS no-kill shelter.

At this month's event, the FAHS van will be in the parking lot to accept donations of food for dogs and cats. FAHS uses the food donations to feed the dogs and cats at the shelter as well as to supply food to struggling families who cannot afford to feed their companion animals.

Inside the store, FAHS volunteers will be greeting visitors with adoptable cats and kittens. Literature about FAHS services also will be available.
