

## **Leaving Time**

Have you ever read a book that you hate to put down? The story is so engaging, interesting and informative that you just want to read even though the timer went off and dinner is ready to take out of the oven?

For me, right now, "Leaving Time" by Jodi Picoult is that book. I "sneak read" when my husband, Wesley, goes into the kitchen for 30 seconds to get a drink of water.

"Leaving Time" is told by four characters. Jenna is a 13 year-old girl missing a mother. Her mission in life is to find her mother, whatever it takes. Virgil is a former police detective and the case of Alice Metcalf is the one that haunts his days, disrupts his nights and ultimately causes him to seek solace in a bottle of Jack Daniels. Serenity is a hasbeen psychic, once very famous until her fall from grace. And Alice is the voice of the missing, she speaks from the past, informing the reader of her life and life decisions.

And there are elephants. I love the bits about the elephants, although I find the facts and information sad, so sad.

In the author's note, Picoult shares some of her research regarding elephants. According to her notes, all of the elephant characters (and they are definitely characters) featured in the book are based on real elephants that have at one time lived a less than happy life in a circus or a
