Around the City.

Regular council meeting to-night. Two breweries are now taking of, one at each end of the city.

The A. B. Field arrived from Tillamook last Sunday afternoon.

Chenamus street between Park and Jackson streets, was improved at last.

C. W. Fulton and wife returned from San Francisco on the Columbian yesterday.

Hiram Gray, who left here about a year ago for a suit, California, has returned, and will make his future home in Astoria.

Mrs. Miller, of Cook's slough, whose life was despaired of a few weeks ago, has much improved in health lately and will probably recover.

On the walls of the Occident hangs a handsomely framed specimen of penmanship, the work of E. C. Clayton, the accomplished penman who resided here.

Ship captains who have been to Portland this season with their vessels do not complain of larrae on the bottoms of their several ships and barks.

The day for the trial of Boyle vs. the Astoria vigilantes, which was set for November 23d, has been changed to Tuesday, November 27th, in the U. S. Circuit Court.

Some large potatoes in Booth & Johns' window attract attention. They are from the Nebelans, and in size and quality show what Clatsop county soil is capable of.

Rescue parties have been sent to the 25th inst., for best sustained lady and gentleman character. They are on exhibition at Adler's.

Captain Clegg of the Edith was down on Sunday evening. His boat is being towed by a lumber tug from the works of J. B. Montgomery.

A fire alarm at 3:20 Sunday afternoon was caused by a burning fire in E. W. Tallant's residence on Concomly street. The department was promptly on hand, but unfortunately their services were not required.

The Gen. Miles arrived in from Gray's harbor Sunday evening with a large number of passengers, mostly men returning from the canneries in that vicinity, who are closing down for the season. She also brought 1837 cases of salmon from the Neptune and Washington packing companies.

SUPPLEMENTARY.—In Sunday's issue mention was made of the J. W. Everman built at Wilmington, in 1855, as being the first iron vessel built in this country. O. T. Henry states that the U. S. iron ship-of-war, Merrimack, was built at Beaufort, North Carolina, in 1855, and that a schooner-rigged, three-masted revenue cutter was built at Cleveland, Ohio, about the same time.

DRY DOCKS.—A company has been formed in San Francisco which intends to go into the business of dry docks on a large scale. Two will be built at San Francisco this winter; one 100 feet long, the other 200 feet long. It is intended to build two of the same dimensions here, one at Seattle, one at Tacoma, one at Honolulu and one at Coos Bay.

FOOD FISHES.—It is now a matter of fact that there are in the Columbia beside the lordly salmon a number of other food fishes, any one of which would make the reputation of a river as a depot for supply. It is considered certain that in a very few seasons should be regularly caught, and from reports in California papers it is believed that striped bass may also be added to the list. They have been on the coast but two years, yet already some fine specimens have been caught at Monterey and elsewhere. Should a few specimens of that fish be placed in the river and let alone, they would doubtless add to the already large number of different fish species, which, in a few years, will make the Columbia the finest fish river on the continent.

A LAWYER IN TROUBLE. Consideration for His Client.

[SPECIAL TO THE ASTORIAN.] PORTLAND, Nov. 12.—A peculiar story of fraud comes to-night from Olympian John P. Judson, a New Tacoma lawyer.

Judson has been arrested by authority of Charles Cotnam of San Francisco, special examiner of the pension bureau, with headquarters at San Francisco, for having withheld pensions for three years from one Wm. Ryan, a veteran of the Mexican war, aged 80 years. He gave bonds in the sum of \$2000 and was released. There are three charges against him: First, for withholding pension money; second, negotiating a draft without authority; in other words, forging a signature thereon, using the name and seal of J. C. McPhaden, a notary public.

Ryan has also brought a civil suit against Judson to recover the money and real estate fraudulently obtained by the wily attorney. Judson has heretofore borne an excellent character, was in good standing, and a prominent Democratic politician, having run as a delegate to congress from Washington Territory in 1876. He pleads in extenuation of the charge that he took it to keep Ryan from squandering it for whisky.

Scarlet Fever.

This dread disease is increasing—we hear of it in every direction. It seems as if it was more virulent in its character than it was in years past. At least it would seem to leave the patient in bad condition—some other disease following after. The symptoms are, first a chill then vomiting and sore throat. A friend who has just carried two children through says, give a thorough cathartic—unless there is looseness of the bowels—then give castor oil all over with hard keep warm, and even after the fever has gone care must be taken or there will be a relapse. If a cold is taken there will be danger of drooping or scurrying. There is danger for weeks after the patient is apparently well; the least exposure may be fatal. It is very hard to keep children from the houses, especially when the mother has many cares of household affairs and cannot watch. In our own observation there has been more fatality from exposure than from the disease itself. There is great danger of contagion in this fever. A lady in Salem lost two children about three years ago from scarlet fever. She laid aside the clothing which with the tender feeling of every loving mother. This summer the little one, that had now grown large enough to wear his clothing, had the disease and came near death from wearing these same garments that had been laid aside for these three years past. After the fever has left there is a sort of peeling off of the outer cuticle or skin. The danger of contagion is worse at this time, and great care should be used that there be no contact with others. It seems hard not to be neighborly in sickness, but every mother should avoid going to assist in sickness if her children are young. We know of well authenticated cases where scarlet fever has been carried just by attending a funeral—by simply being in the room where the dead body lay. A little splash of water before going where this disease is will act as a preventive. It would be well for every family to use sulphur in small doses; still care must be taken least the children drink cold. The children had better not go to school at all if there are any cases in the neighborhood. One thoughtful mother who sends her child to school while the skin is not yet all peeled off will be responsible for the sickness or death of many more. This has been proved in our own city. So each should be careful for the sake of others as well as their own.—Willouette Furver.

Along the Berks.

A small army of men are busy on the O. R. & N. dock. The Star of Erin is discharging fire-clay, and the Anana is finishing fish below. The Ice King, a fine vessel, lies inside. Another fine vessel, the Bremer, was towed down yesterday, and will probably cross out to-day. Vessels are receiving good dispatch this month. The British bark Malaspina, 1035, 173 days from Liverpool, with general cargo arrived in Sunday. The British ship City of Montreal, 1191, Swanmaster, arrived in yesterday afternoon. From Newcastle, N. S. W., with 1000 tons of coal for Capt. Flavel. The Blenheim and Isle of Angleses are in the stream. There were two banks reported outside yesterday afternoon.

Liverpool Salmon Market.

The market for salmon is without exception of any note, and although the stocks of Columbia river are daily becoming smaller, yet the supplies are likely to last out until the arrival of the new season's packing, which is expected to take place in about a month hence. From the peculiar position of the market—few cases having been sold to arrive—great interest is attached to the cargo of the "Enterprise," as on the firmness or weakness of merchants when the goods are on the quay mainly depends the ruling price for the coming season. Another report says that at this time the city grocers give special attention to the new dried fruits arriving, and an active country demand for salmon has somewhat slackened off, as invariably the case. Notwithstanding this fact, however, good daily sales are made, aggregating fully in quantity any previous sales of the season. The latest cable advices report some excitement with different ideas.—Liverpool Corr. London Grocer.
