INDUSTRIOUS SETTLERS.

The Finns residing upon the Columbia river back of Bradbury have secured the right of way of Mr. McGraw for a canal to connect the head of Dobbins slough and Beaver slough with the Columbia, the object being to drain their land and have direct communication with the Columbia for their boats.

Their plan of drainage is based on the fact that the tide in the Columbia river at Bradbury falls two hours and a half earlier than it does in the heads of these two sloughs, which form just back of Bradbury, emptying into the Columbia opposite Eureka and are over twenty miles long, and being very crooked, the action of tide water is so sluggish that one tide is not entirely out before another sets in.

By connecting the head of the slough with the river, as soon as the water begins to raise in the slough it will pour out into the Columbia, which is then at low tide, thus preventing, except at very high tides, the overflow of thousands of acres of fine grazing and hay lands which are now submerged at every tide.

The canal will be nearly half a mile long and will be quite an undertaking, but the Finns are strong hard working fellows, and will accomplish it without delay.

That immense tract of land extending from Bradbury to Marshland, which has heretofore been considered worthless by the Americans, has been taken up by the Finns, who are building good houses and barns and making other substantial improvements.

They are a sober, industrious people and will make a valuable addition to our population. It is their intention, we understand, when they all get title to their lands and are able, to try dyking in order to keep out the June freshets of the Columbia. For the present they intend to cut open ditches to connect with the sloughs, keeping the water drained off the greater part of the year, which will render the land dryer and firmer and enable them to cut large quantities of hay and give the best of pasturage to their cattle.
