

St. Louis, Sept. 17.—Committees of the Democratic and Populist parties, chosen to effect fusion on State and electoral tickets in Missouri, accomplished their purpose today as the far as the electoral ticket is concerned.

The basis of fusion on electors is the withdrawal of four the Democratic ticket and the substitution thereon of a like number of Populist electors, the Populists agreeing to withdraw the remainder of their electoral ticket. This arrangement means thirteen Bryan and Sewell and four Bryan and Watson electors.

The agreement further provides that, as between Watson and Sewell, whoever receives a majority of the fusion electoral votes in the national college, shall be given the combined fusion vote in the Electoral College.

An effort was then made to perfect fusion on the State ticket. Each party has placed a full State ticket in the field. Lon V Stephens Democratic nominee for Governor is a national banker and is necessarily distasteful to the Populists. No agreement was reached.—The World.
