St. Louis, Sept. 17.—Committees of the Democratic and Populistic parties, chosen to effect fusion on State and electoral tickets in Missouri, accomplished their purpose today as the far as the electoral ticket is concerhed.

The basis of fusion on electors is the withdrawal of four the Democratic ticket and the substitution thereon of a like number of Populistic electors, the Populists agreeing to withdraw the remainder of their ejectoral ticket. This ar rangement means thirteen Bryn and Sewell and four Bryan and Watson electors.


The agreement futher provides that, as between Watson and Sewell, whoever receives a majorty · of the fusion electoral votes in the national college, shall be given the combind fusion vote in the Elec toral College.

An effort was then made to perfect fusion on 'theState 'ticket. Each party has placed a full State ticket in the field. Lon V Stephens Democratic nominee for Governor is a national banker, and is neces sarily distasteful to the Populists. No agreement was reachee.-The World.
