

BULLDOGS:

GIRLS BASKETBALL

HERMISTON 52, THE DALLES 39 — At The Dalles, the Bulldogs' game plan was to force the Riverhawks point guard Kailin Hoylman to carry The Dalles' offense, and although she finished with a game-high 18 points it wasn't enough to offset the loss of production from other players.

Maddy Juul paced Hermiston (9-9, 3-1 CRC) with 13 points and seven rebounds, and Jazlyn Romero added nine points and seven rebounds. Kynzee Padilla and Raleigh

Andreason each had eight. "I was very pleased with the way they handled themselves," said Hermiston coach Juan Rodriguez. "It was a tough day, especially for some of the older girls, and they weren't at their best but they did enough."

The Dalles (6-8, 1-3) led by two after the first quarter, but Hermiston went on a 14-5 run in the second quarter to take a 27-20 lead at halftime.

Hermiston hosted Hood River Tuesday, but the score wasn't available by press time. The team will host Pendleton on Thursday at 7:30 p.m., looking to start another winning streak against the Buckaroos after it faltered last week in Pendleton.

For the past 11 years, the Hermiston girls basketball team has reigned supreme over the Pendleton Buckaroos, winning each and every one of the previous 28 meetings

But the Buckaroos wiped away that decade of misery last Tuesday night, as Pendleton outscored Hermiston 30-11 in the fourth quarter to stun the Bulldogs with a 53-48 victory at Warberg Court — the first win for Pendleton since Feb. 17, 2006. Haley Greb hit a 3-pointer with 44.2 seconds left to give Pendleton a 49-48 lead and its first since 2-0, and the Buckaroos (7-6, 3-0 CRC) were able to hang on the rest of the way.

"You like to tell kids that

Hermiston is just another ball game, but it isn't for those kids," Pendleton coach Kevin Porter added. "Hermiston is the gold standard around here and we're trying to get there. I'm so proud of my team, I'm just speechless."

A comeback victory didn't seem feasible for Pendleton throughout the early part of the second half, as the Bucks scored just five points in the third quarter on 2-15 shooting and Hermiston held a commanding 37-23 lead after three quarters. Hermiston (8-9, 2-1) was able to boost that lead to as much as 16 early in the fourth quarter, but the Buckaroos soon began to chip away.

"Our motto is we're nev-

er giving up, no matter how much we're down we're going to give as much effort as we can every single play," said Greb, who finished with a game-high 20 points and added five boards, "and we kept chipping away, chipping away there in the fourth. We didn't look at the scoreboard and we just kept going and it turned out in our favor."

Pendleton was able to outscore Hermiston 18-3 over the final three minutes of the ball game, and Bulldogs coach Juan Rodriguez said that he was disappointed in the way his team performed down the stretch.

"I think our girls started playing in not-to-lose mode

even though we were able to attack the whole game," Rodriguez said. "We were getting good shots and they just went into panic mode in the end and that's a mentality they can't have. We should've extended that lead to 20-25 points and it just started cascading on them and they couldn't pull it out after that."

Hermiston did have a pair of solid offensive performances from freshman guard Jazlyn Romero and senior guard Kynzee Padilla as both tallied a team-high 13 points apiece. Romero scored eight of her 13 in the third quarter, while Padilla added a team-best 10 rebounds as well.

Madison Mitchell led Nyssa (14-7, 5-3 EOL) with 13 points and Britney Arredondo added 11. Nyssa led 30-22 at halftime.

Umatilla (6-14, 1-6) was paced by the game-high 17 points of Aleesha Watson and Charlene Alvarez added 10.

Umatilla played at Vale Tuesday but the score was not available by press time.

IRRIGON 46, RIVERSIDE 27 — At Irrigon, the Irrigon Knights put together a big second half on offense as they outscored Riverside 33-17 in the half to take

down the Pirates on Friday night.

Irrigon (12-8, 5-3 EOL) coach Mike Royer said that the first half was mostly a defensive battle, emphasized by a minimal 13-10 score at halftime with the Knights holding the advantage. But the Knights were able to regroup in the second half and pull away, thanks to a scoring outburst by Alyia Munoz who scored 13 of her game-high 14 points in the second half. Munoz also chipped in four rebounds and five steals for Irrigon.

Also getting into double figures was Taylor Davis

with 13 points and also 10 rebounds. Lacey Mashos led Riverside (8-9, 2-6) with eight points.

Irrigon plays next at home against Nyssa on Friday.

NIXYAAWII 51, ECHO 26 — At Echo, Kaitlynn Melton and Milan Schimmel finished with double-doubles and the Golden Eagles used a lock-down defensive effort in the second half to leave no doubt about Thursday's outcome when they met the Cougars for an Old Oregon League game.

added seven assist for Nixy-aawii (17-0, 10-0 OOL), and Melton and Schimmel both had 11 points and 11 rebounds. Schimmel added six assists.

Devyn Tarin scored 14 points to lead Echo (14-6, 7-4) but the Cougars were limited to just two points total in the third quarter and 11 in the second half.

Echo followed the game up with a 60-28 loss to Powder Valley on Saturday and will wrap up the regular season at home Friday against Wallowa at 6 p.m. and on the road at Cove Saturday at 4 p.m.
