## HUTCHINS NOW WITH AUTO ASSOCIATION

C. C. Hutchins, White Salmon resident for the past 11 years and for six years secretary and manager of the Commercial club there, will move soon to Centralia, where he will become associated with the Western Washington Automobile Association. He will take active charge of organizing motorists of southwestern Washington, he stated while here on a visit last week.

"My work will be chiefly in the interest of good roads and in placing comprehensive road signs," said Mr. Hutchins, "but we are also going to engage in the 'unsigning' of roads. By this I mean that we are going to remove from the rights of way all advertising signs, just to show how advertising signs are encroaching at every point of scenic vantage. We hope to create such a sentiment that land owners will cease leasing rights of billboards on property adjoining highways."

"It will also be our work to provide tourists with comprehensive and correct maps. We will route the tourist on through our state and Oregon and send him on his way into California. We have a legislative committee that is very active. We figure that this committee in the past two years has saved the automobile owners of our state more than a million dollars in cold cash."

## NATIONAL FISH CAMPAIGN IS PLANNED

A visit here Friday of Lewis Radliff, chief of the department of statistics and methods of the United States bureau of fisheries, who conferred with Mrs. Evalene Spencer, who is now growing apples on the West Side, indicates a renewed nationwide campaign of the government to educate the housewife to use of cheaper species of fish and thus materially decrease the cost of feeding large families. Mr. Radliff, who motored up over the Highway accompanied by Henry O'Malley, Pacific fish commissioner, and Carl D. Shoemaker, of the Oregon State Fish and Game Commission, came to seek the services of Mrs. Spencer, who toured the country during the war in popularizing little known species of fish. Efforts will be made, too, it is said, if the educational campaign fully materializes, to secure H. L. Kelly, Oregon City man and well known in fish and game circles of the Pacific coast, to join the movement. Mr. Kelly is now director of the Hawaiian Fish and Game Commission.

## Highway Freight Increasing

The Highway is becoming daily more utilitarian. Freight traffic by motor truck is reaching considerable proportions. The Bridal Veil Lumbering Co. is now supplying their sawmills with stock from the Wind River Lumber Co., at Cascade Locks. Almost daily motor truck loads of lumber are hauled here. A heavy movement of boxed apples from here to Portland is now noticeable. Light freight is coming to Hood River in increasing proportions over the Highway. Three motor truck transport concerns are operating daily between here and the metropolis. Hood River's bread supply now comes largely from Portland, the bread being delivered early each morning by motor trucks.

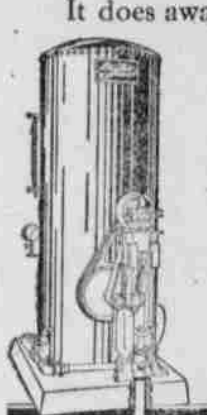
