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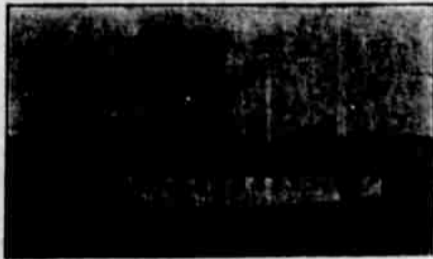

### SENTENCE CROOK'S EX-SHERIFF

Jury Finds C. Sam Smith Guilty of Arson and Judge Bradshaw Imposes Sentence of Four Years in State Penitentiary—Appeal Is Taken

C. Sam Smith, ex-Sheriff of Crook County, and Larkin Elliott, accused of arson in connection with the burning of ex-Congressman J. N. Williamson's sheepshearing plant on the Ochoco River, Crook County, were sentenced to four years each in the penitentiary. Although Elliott turned state's evidence he was given no immunity consideration whatever.

At the opening of court Judge Bradshaw denied the motion for a new trial, whereupon the immediate imposition of sentence was asked. The court ordered the defendant to stand, and asked if he had anything to say why sentence should not be pronounced. Receiving a negative answer, the Judge said: "The sentence of this court is that you be incarcerated in the state penitentiary for the term of four years."

The defendant showed no emotion, either when the verdict was returned or when sentence was pronounced. His counsel at once gave notice of appeal to the Supreme Court and petitioned for a certificate of probable cause, which was granted. This serves to

postpone the execution of sentence until the Appellate Court has passed on the case. The bond of \$2000 on this charge was raised to \$5000. The District Attorney said this offense would be allowed to cover all the indictments, thereby making it plain that there will be no further prosecuting of Smith.

Larkin Elliott entered a plea of guilty Tuesday afternoon. Elliott received his sentence stoically, but the grief of his wife, who was not in court, on learning of her husband's fate, was heart-rending.

It has developed that coercion was used on at least one of the jurors. Juror Faught, the last of the 12 to vote for the conviction charges that Juror Window and others threatened to have him called before the court in case he did not vote with the majority, and accused him of being bribed by the defense to hang the jury. In the presence of several people it is said two jurors admitted that tactics of this questionable nature had been employed in "persuading" jurymen to vote for conviction.
