Butter prices were pushed up a at and a half a pound, to 28 cents, in the local wholesale market to-day. the highest point reached at this period of the season in five years, and there is no assurance that the ost of this commodity will not be

The advance at this time is attribed by the buttermakers to the failire earlier than usual of the pasturage in the dairying districts. As a result of the exceptionally light rainfall in May and June this year, they say the grass dried up at least two weeks sooner than usual, and the ream supply naturally fell off in a serious way. At the same time the demand is as strong as during the flush season of production, and consumption if of course greater than in former years by reason of increase in population.

Some of the buttermakers hold that the output for the State this year will be little if any greater than that of last season. At this time a year ago standard city creamery butter was selling at 25 cents a pound. Two years ago the price was 271/4 cents. At this time in 1905 and 1906 it was going to 21 % cents a pound, 6 1/4 cents under the present price.

The trend of butter prices is always upward at this time of year, but this season the conditions that make for higher prices are a little more marked than usual .- Portland
