PACIFIC HIGHWAY TO COME THIS WAY

Willamette Valley Towns Do Not Take Proper Amount of Interest and, as a Result Present May be Changed

Klamath Falls may yet be on the Pacific Highway. The leaders of the highway movement at a meeting held in Portland a few days ago seriously considered the abandoning of the present route through the Willamette Valley and the adoption of the route through this county.

This because of Willamette Valley indifference, and east of the mountains anxiety to be known as the route of a tourist thoroughfare that not only has been marked from British Columbia to Mexico, but has been advertised and approved in publications circulating throughout the United States.

The Pacific Highway advocates were guests of Samuel Hill at luncheon in the Oregon hotel, followed by Mr. Hill's illustrated lecture on the good roads opportunity of the West, including a pictorial showing of the scenery that matches the famed resorts of Europe, yet is inaccessible from lack of roads.

Such is the desire of the people of Crook, Wasco and Klamath counties for the Pacific Highway that they have already laid out the route," declared Phil S. Bates, representative in Oregon of the government office of roads.

Judge William S. Worden of Klamath, the most progressive county judge in Oregon in the matter of roads, has secured an agreement with the authorities of Siskiyou county, California, providing for connection with the Pacific Highway in California. He has provided two routes around Klamath Lake, one as good as the other, each furnishing continuous views of Mt. Shasta and Mt. Pitt. He

has cleared the road and made it perfect for automobiles from Klamath Falls to Crescent and from that point on to the county line.

"From that point in Crook county there are a variety of roads most excellently fitted for auto use, and the same is true of Wasco county. All the way snow capped mountains are in view. The greatest possible variety of entrancing scenery is constantly presented. South of Bend one finds an entire township of lava beds, the like of which cannot be found elsewhere.

"In addition to all this the road is in easy use ten months of the year at least," continued Mr. Bates, who recently returned from a trip to interior Oregon. "In the Willamette Valley the road cannot be used more than seven months out of the year, and such was the apathy of the road builders and such the weather this year that two months' use was about all.

"Where roads are most needed in the Willamette Valley the people are in the narrowest and deepest darkness. They have no appreciation of the value of better built highways, though they need them worse than any place else in Oregon. They spend time in falsely representing the road bills and in futile bickerings that should be spent in support of a system that will provide good roads for a district that is lost without them. I don't think there is any question but that the roads and scenery and interest of the people east of the mountains will win from the Willamette Valley a tourist road worth millions in revenue for which the people are proving themselves unfit."

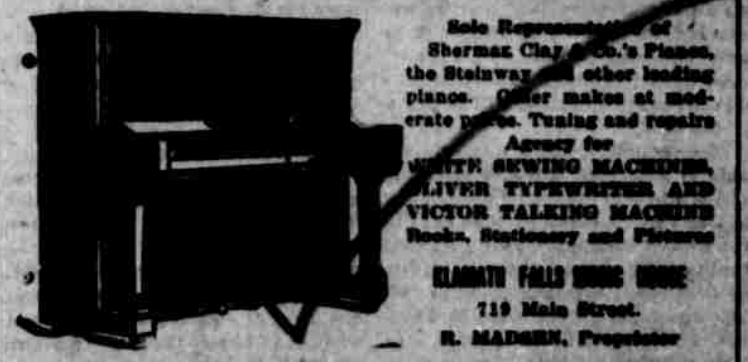
