HELSINGFORS, FINLAND, JUNE 3 The most formidable blow of any of the many armed at Finnish autonomy in the past few years, in the opinion of all classes here, was the bill brought up in the Russian Duma today at Se Petersburg. The bill requires that all Fins that resist Russian made laws must be tried by a Russian court.
