# Episcopals Holding an Important Meeting

United Press Service NEW YORK, Oct. 8.—Uniform laws for divorce, the demand that certificates of health be presented by all brides and bridegrooms, the question of changing the name to "American Catholic Church" or merely the "American Church," and the proposal to let the public into seasons of the House of Bishops were the important subjects to be discussed at the general convention of the Protestant Episcopal Church in the United States and Territory Beyond the Seas, when the meeting opened today at the Church of St. John the Divine.

Because the questions which will be considered and settled the convention which opened today is expected to be the most important ever held by the church. Perhaps the most important question to the church body will be whether the House of Bishops shall meet behind closed doors, as it has during the 12 years there have been general conventions. A hot contest is expected to come.
