This plan will be adopted in order to make Ashland a notable resort town. Waters of acknowledged therapeutic value are available. Sulphur waters in abundance are already within the city limits. Lithia springs are four miles distant and numerous soda springs are found from three to twelve miles from depot and plaza. Experts have demonstrated the feasibility of piping these waters direct to town, there being enough fall to acomplish this by gravity. Once piped in they will be free to the public

Superin endent Butterfield of the electric light department reported that unless we get rain soon there will be a shortage of water in the upper reaches of Ashland creek and the city's hydroelectric power and lighting plant will be seriously handicapped. The city faced a similar condition a year ago last fall, but at that time the load carried by the plant was not so great, and it pulled through. The plant is now heavily loaded, the fall season has been dry, the waters in both forks of Ashland Creek are getting low. Already the plant is drawing on the reservoirs. An early rain would reeve the condition.—Ashland Record
