WASHINGTON, Jan. 10.—The house committee on banking and currency by a decisive vote pushed the Andrew banking and bullion purchase bill, together with the Cate amendment for the coinage of the silver bullion now in the treasury, through the committee, and ordered it reported to the house.

An Eastern Oregon Matter. UNION, Or., Jan. 10.—A large delegation of the Union county bar held a meeting here to discuss measures of interest to the legal fraternity to be presented to the legislature, and they passed resolutions favoring the proposed division of the Sixth and seventh judicial districts into four districts as follows: The Sixth to consist of Umatilla and Morrow counties, and the Seventh to remain as now, except that Morrow county will be added to the Sixth; the Eighth to consist of Union and Walla Walla counties, and the Ninth to consist of the counties of Baker, Grant, Harney and Malheur.

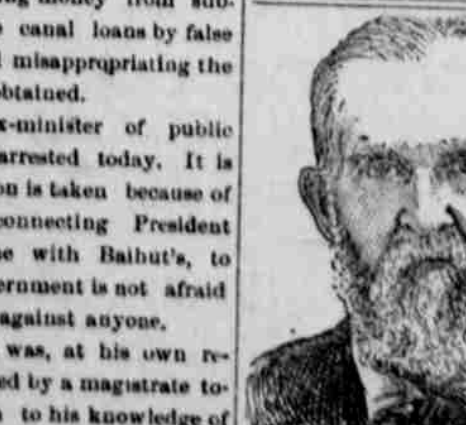
