Novel but Energetic Use of the Scriptures

Kahuna Thumps his Patient to Death With it in Trying to Drive out Devils

There has been another outbreak of kahunaism in Hawaii, with the result that one of the soremost, or kahunas, is in prison in Puna, Hawaii, awaiting trial on a charge of manslaughter.

The case is one of the most unique in the annals of kahunaism in the islands. It appears from the story told at the trial in the district court that a native in the Puna district became ill, and the government physician, Dr. Holland, was called in.

The kahuna was arrested, first on the charge of practicing witchcraft, but afterward the charge was changed to manslaughter. The man made no defense. He said that he had done his best for his patient, but the devil had conquered.

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This case has caused an investigation to be made of the practice of kahunaism in the islands. Kahunaism is prohibited by law. It is a relic of ancient Hawaii, and all the efforts of the missionaries, from the day of their arrival, have been insufficient to stamp it out.

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doctor in Lahaina, on Maui, was sent to prison for causing the death of a father and two sons, who, she said, had killed the pet cat of her favorite niece.

The kahuna has of late become somewhat modernized, or perhaps it is only that fakits have replaced the real thing. Many of them are blackmailers, pure and simple. They claim power to summon spirits at will, and unless they receive everything they want in the form of money or food the credulous native is likely to suffer from their wiles.

The kahuna also claims the power of praying a person to death, and it is not infrequent that cases are reported, too, where these witches are employed for this purpose. Some cases are reported, too, where the kahuna has been successful for the prayers so work upon the fears of the superstitious native that it is no wonder he dies.

The present law seems sufficient to curb the kahuna, but it is doubtful whether it can ever be strengthened until the white man outnumber the native in the territory and can control the legislature.

Barr be appointed guardian of his person and estate. The estate is valued at \$12,000, and consists of real and personal property in and near Salem.
