Port Arthur Strong.

Indianapolis, June 20.—Hector Fuller, staff correspondent of the News, cables his paper from Chee Foo today as follows: "After spending five days in a Russian prison, I was released and put aboard of a Chinese junk, and sent to this place. The stories of Starvation in Port Arthur, which have been spread by the Japanese, are untrue, as stores of supplies are constantly arriving at the besieged city from Chinese ports. The Japanese blockade is ineffective. The garrison consists of between 50,000 and 60,000 troops, and the health of both soldiers and civilians is good. The damage to the battleships have all been repaired, and the harbor entrance cleared of obstructions. Immense new forts have been constructed, and in my opinion, the place is in no immediate danger of falling into the hands of the Japanese. Their attack by land and sea, made on June 8th, was easily repulsed. Fuller is the first war correspondent to enter the place since it was blockaded.
