

Japs Forced Enemy to Retire in Disorder

The Vladivostock Fleet Is Again Reported Hovering Around Tokio

London, June 28 .- Japanese Minister Hayashi this morning issues the following report of fighting between the Russian and Japanese forces which landed at Taku Shan: "The Taku Shan army, after six hours' of severefighting on the 27th, occupied Fern Huiling, 13 miles northwest of Siuyen, The enemy, consisting of five battations of infantry, two regiments of cavalry and 16 guns, fled in disorderly fashion toward Tomu Ching and Shimu Cheng. Our casulaties are estimated at 100."
