Willamette Football Team Is Received With Open Arms by Co-eds and all

Almost the entire student body of the University was out to the early morning train to welcome home the football team. Willamette has always been noted for the loyalty of the student body, but never was such cheering heard as greeted the ears of the husky boys, as they stepped from the train this morning.

When the news reached the city Saturday evening that the team had succeeded in holding down the famous California eleven to no score, the enthusiasm of the students and the friends of the old school knew no bounds.
