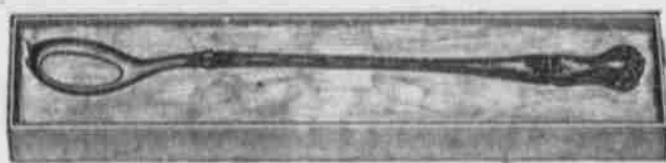

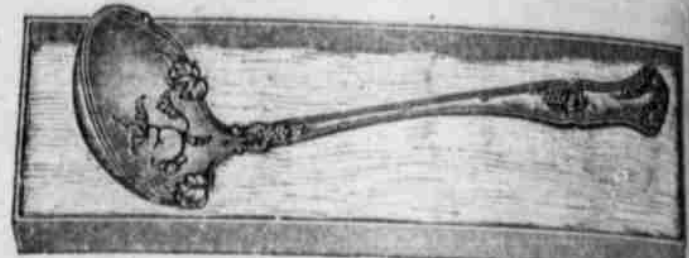

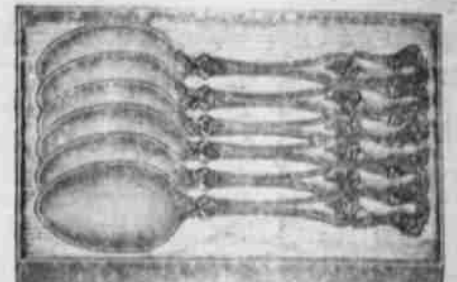

WOMAN ARRESTED FOR BOLD ROBBERY.
A woman giving her name as Lillian Jones was arrested this morning by Deputy Sheriff Minto near the postoffice, in this city, who is wanted in Portland to answer to a charge of larceny.
The arrest was made upon information furnished by Detective Thos. McKay, of Portland, who, with the plaintiff, a miser by the name of Anderson, traced the woman to this city. During the early part of the week the woman met Anderson on the street of Portland, where, it is

alleged, she invited him to visit her at her rooms. Anderson called, and the woman, in treating her visitor, gave him some knock-out drops and relieved of \$450, a gold watch and several pieces of jewelry, such as stick pins and chains.
At the time of her arrest the woman had with her two little children and after being captured by the officers confessed that she took the money and jewelry from Anderson. The watch and chain and \$120 were found on her person. The prisoner will be taken to Portland this afternoon, and the children placed in the Boys' and Girls Aid Society.
Mrs. Jones had rooms at the Salem lodging house while in the city.

Chicago, Nov. 16.—Policeman Robert Mackeney was found dead at Sixty-third street and the north avenue today, only two blocks away from the Englewood police headquarters. The murderer escaped, although persons who saw the shots saw a man running at high speed down Sixty-third street a few minutes after the shooting. He is believed to have been the assassin.
