CLEVELAND IS AGAIN VERY ILL

Chicago, June 4.—It is believed here that ex-President Cleveland has suffered a relapse and is seriously ill at his home in Princeton, because of the hurried departure for New York today of Dr. Joseph D. Bryant, retiring president of the American Medical association.
Dr. Bryant refused to assign any reason for his trip and the rumor gained ground rapidly that he had been hurriedly called to the bedside of Cleveland, whom Dr. Bryant has been attending for years.
Cleveland was recently removed from Lakewood to his home in Princeton, Dr. Bryant is a personal friend of the ex-president.

Portland, June 4.—After saving himself and Bert Cohn from death in the icy waters of the Willamette river last night, Miss Alma Hollingsworth, prominent in society, is today being proclaimed the bravest girl in Portland.
Miss Hollingsworth accompanied Cohn in a canoe last night while he was setting off some of the red fire which illuminated the marine parade. Cohn is not much of a swimmer and he grabbed the gunwale of the boat. The girl is an expert swimmer, and despite her clinging garments and the chill water, easily made her way to a bridge pier 150 yards away.
Finding herself in a place of safety Miss Hollingsworth thought of her companion's welfare and seeing his predicament swam out to meet the drifting craft and aided Cohn to reach the bridge.

OFFICER FACES A COURTMARTIAL

San Francisco, June 4.—Captain Samuel D. McAllister, of the Thirty-eight company coast artillery, who disappeared for about a week from the Presidio post several weeks ago, is to face a courtmartial for having been absent without leave, next Saturday.
McAllister has been under arrest at the post since May 23 but the absence of General Funston prevented the courtmartial. Funston has wired orders for the trial and Colonel J. A. Lunden has filed the charges.
It is expected that McAllister will plead guilty and take a dismissal from the army.

BIG ORE STRIKE IN NEVADA

Ely, Nev., June 4.—News of a rich silver strike in the Kawich range near Warm Springs was brought here today by prospectors returning from that section of the state. A rich vein of the white metal has been uncovered and great excitement prevails. The new camp has been named Silverfield.
The strike that is creating so much excitement is near the famous Never Sweat strike that first attracted attention to that section of Nevada last year. Twenty-five-ton shipments of ore from that mine last year went \$156 to the ton. The ore contains gold in stringers.
