SPECULATE ON RETIREMENT OF RAILROAD OFFICIAL

San Francisco, July 1.—Following close on the heels of the announcement of the resignation of Thomas Lawson from the general superintendency of the western division of the Southern Pacific here, came the announcement today that W. A. McGovern will succeed Lawson in the high post. McGovern was formerly superintendent of the coast division which is to be entrusted to the Thomas Ahearn, now superintendent of the Shasta division. No one has yet been selected to take Ahearn's place. There is much speculation as to the real reason for Lawson's retirement. He came here last November from the general superintendency of the Chicago & Northwestern to which road he has returned.

Herbert will probably have the distinction of being the oldest delegate at Denver. He is 76 years old and has been a resident of the islands for over 40 years. Harvey is the only native of Hawaii in the delegation. He is one of the supervisors of Oahu county.
